## $\underline{7}^{\text {th }}$ Grade Supplies 2019-2020

The $7^{\text {th }}$ grade team encourages students to "color code" their materials so that they can organize and locate their materials more easily. This is not a requirement, but is a helpful strategy for many students. If possible, please pick up supplies that are red for social studies, blue for science, green for math, and purple for ELA. Additional classes would not have blue, green, purple, or red materials.

We also request that every seventh grade boy bring in a box of tissues and every girl bring in a box of pencils for their homeroom classes. Each student will benefit from these supplies during the year!

Please note: This is a list of general supplies, but we understand that each student has a different approach to organization. If he/she would like to ask his/her teachers about an alternate organization system, they may do so the first week of school before purchasing supplies.
