
## **Positive Case: Isolation Flowchart**



## DEFINITIONS AS OF JANUARY 10 (subject to change)

\*1Immunocompromised—Your immune system is weakened, and you may be at higher risk for severe COVID-19 disease. \*2 Isolation separation of sick individuals from healthy to avoid disease spread. \*3 Well-fitting mask—Fits snugly against your face and is multiple layers. \*4 Some individuals may be unable to wear a well-fitting mask. They include anyone under 2 years of age, and those of any age with certain disabilities or health conditions. Certain types of facial hair, such as beards, can make mask fitting difficult. A well-fitting mask better protects the both the wearer and those around them. Masks designed for those with beards are currently being evaluated.
