All-Remote Learning Overview

September 2020

As part of its planning for the upcoming school year, the Haldane Central School District made available an “all remote” option for families who were not yet comfortable sending their children back to school given ongoing concerns stemming from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Families were surveyed through the week of August 11 to determine the number of families who had chosen this option. Approximately 20% of students are scheduled to receive all remote instruction at the start of the school year.

All families who have their children participate in remote learning are indicating that their children will remain in this environment for the first 10 weeks of the school year, through November 13, 2020.

Students in Grades K-12 will participate in synchronous classroom experiences, following their regular class schedule each day. These sessions will be facilitated via Zoom as the classroom teacher screencasts his/her classroom notes. Additional classroom materials will be posted via Google Classroom. Teachers will be provided with additional time each school day to follow-up with students who are learning remotely. This time will be utilized to post assignments, answer questions, and facilitate additional content area support. Classroom sessions will be recorded and posted on Google Classroom.
