Haldane fifth graders recently explored Little Stony Point on a beautiful sunny day. The walking trip was an entry event for their unit on crafting fictional narratives set at Little Stony Point.



Spotlight on Science

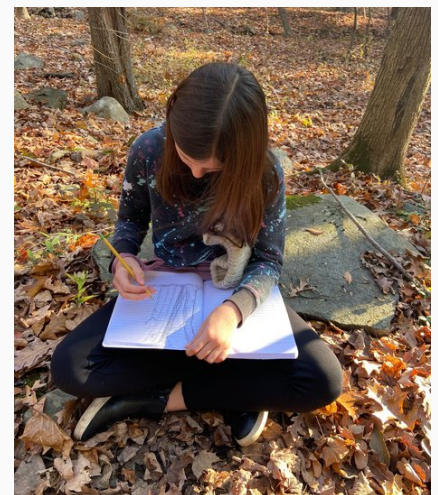
Sixth grade science classes tell the Earth's story while pondering their own.



Mark Wick's 6th grade scientists headed outdoors to explore the Earth's history. Students stretched a 46 meter long rope to represent 4.6 billion years of the Earth's existence; each centimeter equaled one million years. Laminated cards were placed along the way marking various events such as the first discoveries of life in the ocean, land plants, and amphibians. When they finally reached the beginning of the timeline, students quickly saw how human existence as we know it only takes up fractions of a centimeter. Turning around, they saw the vast rope behind them representing the rest of "Earth's Story."



After a hike to a nearby stream and wooded area, students were asked to ponder their existence on Earth and express themselves however they felt comfortable. Some sketched their surroundings, some wrote poetry or free-wrote, and some quietly explored the area for natural treasures. The goal of this geology unit is for students to be able to view a natural setting and "tell a story of a place."



Haldane Students Perform at NYSSMA Area All-State Festival

Four high school students from the Haldane music program were selected for this year's New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA) Area All-State Festival. Sophie Sabin and Conrad White participated in the mixed choir and Elaine Llewellyn (flute) and Robert Freimark (piano) participated in the band. Students are selected for Area-All State based on their NYSSMA Solo Festival score from the previous year. All of the accepted students from Haldane earned the highest level solo score, a 98 or better on a level 6 solo.

During the Area All-State Festival students from Putnam, Dutchess, and Columbia counties rehearsed together for two days and then performed a concert at the end of the weekend. Area-All State was held on November 19 and 20 at Brewster High School.

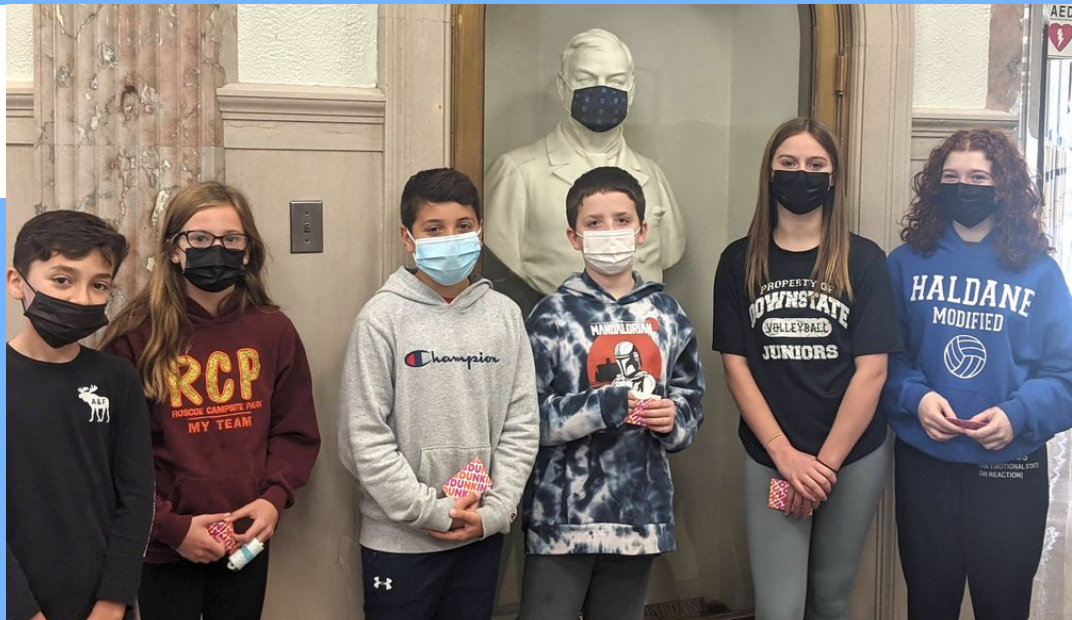

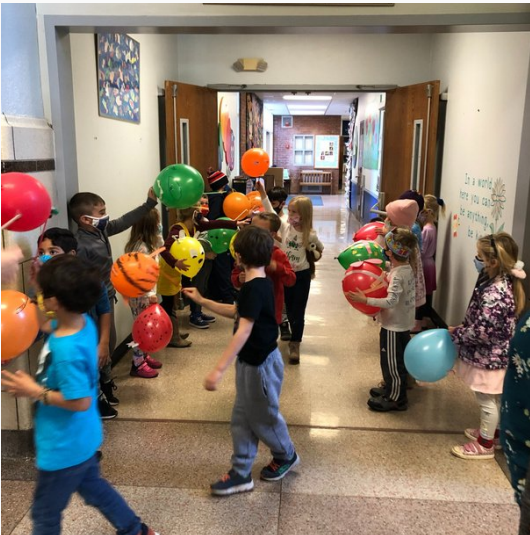
